

AWARDS CEREMONIES MAP & INFO

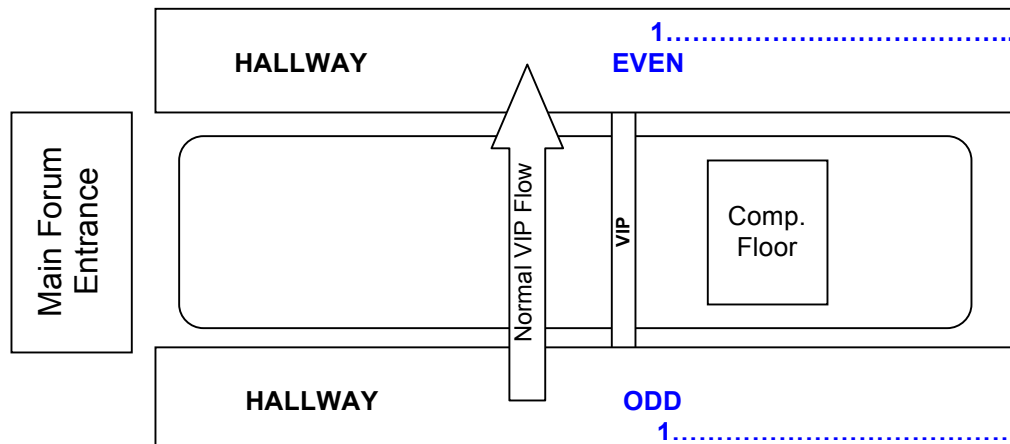
We are doing our best to make sure that traffic for the awards ceremonies is controlled and organized, that everyone makes it onto the floor for their awards and the process allows us to stay on schedule during the event. First, find your TEAM NUMBER. This is located in the first column on the CheerExpo competition schedule. Your team number is the same for both days. Next check when your awards ceremony is for your team. You will need to meet in the line about 5-10 minutes before the awards ceremony starts.

When an award ceremony is about to start, the spectators in the VIP area will be blocked in to let the athletes onto the floor on BOTH ENDS of the VIP viewing area. So in the example above, the fans of Extreme All-Stars Lime will be blocked in while the Mini and Junior 3 teams come onto the floor. Once everyone is in, the spectators will be let out in the direction of Normal VIP Flow and the spectators for the next team (Club X's Pink Ladies) will filter in the usual side to get ready to watch them while the awards ceremony is happening.



If your team is an ODD number, you will line up in the hallway on the same side that the VIP line always lines up, but in the opposite direction (behind the number 1...the dots represent team members to show the direction of the line up. If your team is an EVEN number, you will line up in the hallway where the EXIT for the VIP area normally is, again, behind the number 1. Once the award ceremony is over, your team should exit the same way that you entered...ODD on one side, EVEN on the other. In order to make this all work, please make sure that everyone involved understands this process and where they should enter & exit the floor for awards ceremonies.
